CUSTOMS ACT (R.S.A. c. C169)
CUSTOMS (DECLARATION FORM) REGULATIONS

Note: These Regulations are enabled under section 89(1) of the Customs Act, R.S.A. c. C169.

Declaration Form

1. (1) Every person entering Anguilla shall make the declarations referred to in section 89(1) of the Customs Act by completing the form set out in the Schedule, or a form to like effect.

(2) A person referred to in subsection (1) may make the declarations referred to in subsection (1) on behalf of—

- (a) his or her spouse; or
- (b) any child who has not attained the age of 18 years;

who is entering Anguilla with the person referred to in subsection (1).

(3) Subsection (1) does not apply to any person on whose behalf the declarations are made under subsection (2).

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Declaration Form) Regulations, Revised Regulations of Anguilla C169-9.

NOTICE

Passengers are reminded that they are required by law to make a full and true declaration to the Customs Officer

The amount of duty to be paid will be determined by the Customs Officer based upon the value declared and in accordance with the appropriate tariff. Where information, declarations, evidence or documentation is not satisfactory, the Customs Officer may assess the price which, in his opinion, the goods would fetch on a sale in the open market.

All persons are subject to further questioning and their personal belongings, baggage, and their person are subject to search.

Failure to make a declaration may render you guilty of an offence under Section 89(3) of the Customs Act and liable to a fine of \$10,000 or 3 times the value of the goods, whichever is greater. Making a false declaration may render you guilty of an offence under Section 116(1) or (2) of the Customs Act, and liable to a fine of up to EC\$20,000 or 2 years imprisonment or both. Anything which is not declared or which is the subject of a false declaration, is liable to forfeiture.

There are exemptions for:

- (1) Belongers of Anguilla and returning residents in relation to used personal effects and baggage and, where such persons have been abroad for more than 72 hours, also purchases and gifts to the value of EC\$50 for each adult and EC\$25 for each child under 18 years;
- (2) Visitors in relation to personal effects and baggage compatible with intended length of stay, where they intend to stay for less than 6 months
