Revised Regulations of Anguilla: C169-4

CUSTOMS ACT (R.S.A. c. C169)

CUSTOMS (PORTS AND AIRPORTS) REGULATIONS

Note: These Regulations are enabled under sections 11 and 13 of the Customs Act, R.S.A. c. C169.

Ports

1. The areas specified in Schedule 1 are appointed and named as ports for the purposes of customs.

Customs airport

2. The areas specified in Schedule 2 are appointed and named as customs airport.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Ports and Airports) Regulations, Revised Regulations of Anguilla C169-4.

SCHEDULE 1

(Section 1)

PORTS

1.	Road Bay	The port of Road Bay shall encompass all that area of sea and land commencing at the mean of the highest and lowest water mark at Road Bay beach extended on both sides of the main pier to the extremities of the beach and proceeding seawards along the coast to an imaginary straight line 1,000 yards seawards from the mean shore line where no reef exists or to the seawards edge of the furthest reef and shall include the harbour and piers situated within such area.
2.	Blowing Point	The port of Blowing Point shall encompass all that area of sea and land commencing at the mean of the highest and lowest water mark at Blowing Point beach extending on both sides of the pier to the extremities of the beach and proceeding seawards to the seaward edge of the furthest reef or to a distance of 1,000 yards seawards from the mean shore line where no reef exists and shall include the harbour and pier situated within such area.
3.	Wallblake Airport	The port of Wallblake shall encompass all that area known as Wallblake Airport.

SCHEDULE 2

(Section 2)

CUSTOMS AIRPORT

Customs Airport The customs airport shall encompass all that area linking the terminal building and the landing strip and the precints of such area extending east to the fence immediately above the Wallblake customs warehouse and a distance approximately 150 yards south and west from the central point of the terminal building.
