**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given by virtue of the Distribution and Price of Goods Act R.S.A c D30, His Excellency the Governor, Tim Foy has appointed the Comptroller of Customs as the Supply Officer in Anguilla for the purposes of the Act.

Further by virtue of Section 2 of the Distribution and Price of Goods Act, the Hon. Minister of Trade and Commerce Mr. Kyle Hodge has extended the Order under Schedule 2 of the Distribution and Price of Goods (Maximum Price Order) Regulations, which establishes an instructive of a list of price-controlled, until 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.

The order by the Minister instructs that for goods listed sold by retail, the maximum price shall be the C.I.F value plus 40% mark-up and for goods listed sold by wholesale the maximum price shall be the C.I.F value plus 20% mark-up.

The Customs Department requires that all wholesalers and retailers stocking and selling price controlled goods to submit to the Comptroller of Customs (the Supply Officer) a Price List of the price-controlled goods for approval, to be ultimately posted at the Wholesalers and Retailers premises.

The Anguilla Customs Department Compliance Officers will visit the premises to verify compliance with the Maximum Price Order.
